ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

Upon review of the record, it appears that the circuit court's August 30, 2004 order dismissing Civil No. 04-1-1455 has not been reduced to a separate judgment, as required by HRCP 58. See Jenkins v. Cades Schutte Fleming & Wright, 76 Hawai'i 115, 869 P.2d 1334 (1994); Price v. Obayashi, 81 Hawai'i 171, 176, 914 P.2d 1364, 1371 (1996). Thus, this appeal is premature and we lack jurisdiction. Therefore,
