1. Case-based reporting: A criminal traffic case involving multiple offenses is counted as one case, and the most serious offense is selected for classification purposes. For example, a case involving a felony offense and one or more misdemeanor offenses is reported as one felony case.

2. Revised.

3. Reopened case: A case in which judgment has previously been entered but which has been restored to the court's pending caseload due to the filing of a request to modify or enforce the existing judgment. When the reopened case is disposed of, the case is reported in the Dispositions column labeled Reopened.

4. Inactive case: A case is placed on inactive status if the defendant has absconded, an arrest order has been issued, and the court has suspended activity until the defendant is apprehended. A case on inactive status is Reactivated when the court resumes activity on that case.

Calculating Pending Caseloads:

Begin Pending (Active) + New Filing + Reopened + Reactivated - Entry of Judgment - Reopened Dispositions - Placed on Inactive Status = End Pending (Active).

Begin Pending (Inactive) - Reactivated + Placed on Inactive Status = End Pending (Inactive).
