SUMMARY DISPOSITION ORDER

Defendants Alice Bernades Canales and Randford Lee Canales appeal the May 12, 2003 order of the Circuit Court of the Fifth Circuit (circuit court)¹ that denied the March 20, 2003 motion they brought, pursuant to Hawai'i Rules of Civil Procedure Rule 60(b) (2003), to set aside the circuit court's July 20, 2001 judgment and underlying order of even date granting summary judgment in favor of Plaintiff First Union National Bank.
