ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL PURSUANT TO HRAP RULE 30
(By: Recktenwald, C.J., Watanabe and Nakamura, JJ.)

Upon review of the record, it appears that:

- (1) Defendant-Appellant Calvert A. Williamson filed a notice of appeal on August 30, 2007; (2) on October 29, 2007, the appellate clerk filed a notice of entering case on calendar and notified Appellant the jurisdictional statement was due on November 8, 2007 and the opening brief was due on December 8, 2007;
- (3) Appellant did not file the jurisdictional statement or the opening brief; (4) on January 11, 2008, the appellate clerk informed Appellant that: (a) the time to file the statement of jurisdiction and the opening brief expired; (b) the matter would be brought to the attention of the court on January 18, 2008 for such action as the court deems proper; and (c) the appeal may be dismissed pursuant to HRAP Rule 30; and (5) Appellant did not file the statement of jurisdiction and the opening brief or seek relief from default. Therefore,

pursuant to HRAP Rule 30.
