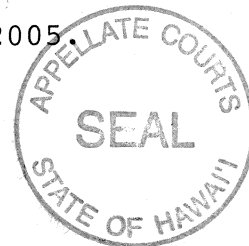
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Petitioner ODC's motion for partial reconsideration of the October 17, 2005 order denying reinstatement is denied.
