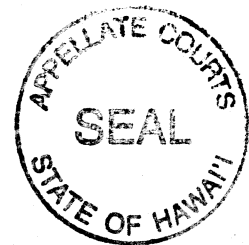
ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
