Upon review of the record, it appears that a final decree on the complaint for divorce has not yet been entered in FC-D No. 03-1-3701. 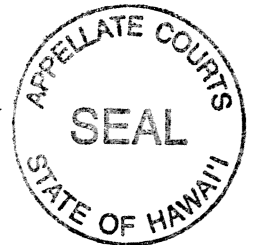
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this appeal is dismissed for lack of appellate jurisdiction.
